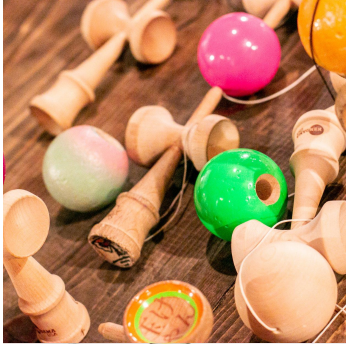

Ikebana

Japanese Flower Arrangement

[online / in-person]

Ikebana (Japanese flower arrangement) expresses the beauty and elegance of nature by transforming flowers into works of art. RESOBOX Ikebana classes offer a peaceful getaway from participant's busy life, a way to enhance creativity and provide inspiration.

Sumi-e

Japanese Ink Painting

[online / in-person]

Originally developed as part of Buddhist rituals, Sumi-e is a style of black and white painting using ink made from charcoal. Participants learn to express themselves using pure, unadorned simple forms.



Optional - Participants can create original labels for bottles of Japanese sake, craft beer, soft drinks.

Japanese Miniature Trees

[in-person]

Bonsai is the art of growing miniature artistic trees. RESOBOX bonsai classes teach participants how to prune, shape and maintain bonsai trees. After the class, participants can take their bonsais home. Bonsais are ideal for indoor apartment growing. RESOBOX bonsai classes are a spiritual yet disciplined experience, helping participants to focus on calmness, simplicity, and self-growth.
